- Pale or mottled skin
- Confusion or sleepiness
- Fever and chills
- Feeling the sickest you've ever felt
- Extreme pain

BEFORE A CT SCAN

Before a CT scan, common with concussions, remember the COOL approach and talk with your child's doctor.

Consider using other testing (*without radiation*) when appropriate


Only image the indicated area

Only scan once

Lowest amount of radiation should be used, based on child dosing

ULTRASOUND IS INCREASINGLY A POWERFUL TOOL FOR TREATING CHILDREN IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION. INSPIRE NETWORK AND POCUS.

Despite the growing use of ultrasound, there have been no published guidelines specific to pediatric emergency medicine. R Baby is investing in this important medical diagnostic tool through grants with the INSPIRE Network-New York Presbyterian Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital, led by Dr. David Kessler and the Point of Care Ultrasound Training Curriculum (POCUS) at Rutgers Robert Wood Johnson Medical School in Association with Bristol-Myers Squibb Children's Hospital, Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital led Dr. Earnest Leva.
